

What information does JEC collect? Why does JEC collect my information?

JEC Connect collects information from Members, including:

- Full name
- School
- Gender
- Chapter
- Graduation year
- Email

This information is used to identify Members and maintain our Member database. Your full name, school, gender, chapter and graduation year will be visible to other Members on the JEC Directory. This information is not publicly accessible.

Your email is never revealed to other Members, except if you explicitly authorize its disclosure. Currently, the only instance where your email address would be revealed to another Member is if you contact them through JEC Connect.

Optionally, Members may also choose to provide:

- A profile picture
- A 'bio'
- Phone number

If provided, your profile picture and 'bio' will be displayed on your page in the Directory. The Directory is only available to registered JEC Members. Your profile photo, like all information provided to JEC, is stored securely and not publicly accessible on the Internet.

Your phone number, if provided, will not be shared with other Members. It will be used only for the purposes of communicating directly with you, including:

- To protect your account, by sending multi-factor authentication codes and security alerts
- To deliver event notifications, including reminders and logistical instructions
- To send surveys and collect feedback

JEC also collects usage data for security and analytics purposes. This data is linked to your account and may include:

- The device on which you use the app
- The IP address associated with your usage of the app
- The app features you interacted with
- When you interacted with the app

How does JEC protect my information?

JEC never discloses, shares, sells or otherwise transfers any information relating to Members or their usage of our platforms to external entities. Internally, JEC adheres to strict security and compliance guidelines to safeguard your information:

- Databases containing Member information are siloed between chapters, so your information is not visible to leadership from other chapters
- Databases have strict access control policies in place to prevent unauthorized access, and all access by leadership is logged for compliance purposes
- All activity is constantly monitored and analyzed by cybersecurity protection services to identify and remediate vulnerabilities and detect unauthorized access
- All cloud providers which provide services to JEC comply with industry standards and relevant certifications for data protection

However, please be aware that while JEC abides by strict cybersecurity practices, no communication over the Internet is guaranteed to be fully secure.

How can I view, modify and/or delete any information collected by JEC about myself?

JEC cares about your privacy. We comply with all relevant privacy laws in jurisdictions in which we operate, which may govern your right to view, modify and/or delete any information JEC collected about you.
